Peace House has selected Kendra Wyckoff as its new Executive Director. Kendra comes to Peace House from her role as Executive Director of Safe Harbor Crisis Center, a domestic-violence and rape-crisis center in Davis County. Kendra is the mother of one son, age 25, and three daughters, ages 20, 11, and 6. Her husband, Justin, is a sergeant with the West Valley Police Force. Wyckoff said her family will relocate to the Wasatch Back.

Please join us at the Coffee, when Kendra will update us on the \$11 million dollar campus being built at Quinn’s Junction. The facility will include 22 housing units, with eight units for emergency shelter, 12 units for traditional housing and 2 units for employees. Former Peace House Executive Director, Jane Patten, who Wyckoff is replacing, is the project manager for the new campus.
